

CALL FOR PAPERS CHINA – U.S. CONFERENCE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES IN DISASTER MANAGEMENT

9-Day Conference and Study Program

September 9-19, 2009

The Conference format will include keynote and featured speakers, as well as presenters for breakout sessions. Breakout sessions will be 90 minute interactive sessions. The session will feature both a Chinese and U.S. or international speaker. Presentations should be designed to generate a conversation with the audience around the presentation topic. The speaker will present a 15-minute presentation (requiring a total of 30 minutes including interpretation), followed by the second speaker. An interactive discussion will be facilitated after both presentations have been heard to distinguish the similarities and differences between the approaches, policies, or practices. All participants are required to participate fully in the four days of the Conference. Each presenter must submit a full paper for the interpreter.

SUBMITTING A PROPOSAL

All submissions must address the Symposium topics listed below. Submissions must include **3** documents:

- 1) 250 word abstract,
- 2) The major points of the presentation and the outcomes the participant can expect from participating in the session,
- 3) 1 page biographical sketch, not to exceed 250 words.
